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1. General information

1.1 About these instructions

This manual is intended for use by

- studio operator.
- qualified, trained and authorized service technicians.

Any person handling, mounting or servicing this tanning device must have read and understood these instruction. This manual describes tanning devices equipped with the maximum number of features. Keep this manual ready to hand at all times.

1.2 Safety signs



This symbol indicates that general hazards exist for the human health.



This symbol indicates that due to electrical tensions hazards exist to the human health.



This symbol indicates that due to falling loads hazards exist to the human health.



This symbol indicates the danger of pinching.

When assembling heavy components, you can pinch your fingers or hands.



This symbol indicates the danger of burns from hot lamps and housing parts. If the tanning device was operated before being opened, lamps and housing parts may be hot.



This symbol indicates that damages may occur at the tanning device, at the material or at the environment.

Danger due to leakages.

The tanning device can be damaged by leaking connections.

• Slide the plastic tube **up to the stop** into the quick connector socket.

1.4 Definitions

STUDIO OPERATOR

People who provide tanning devices to users on a commercial basis. The studio operator is trained to operate and maintain the tanning device. He is responsible for the proper operation of the tanning device as well as for compliance with the maintenance intervals.

QUALIFIED, TRAINED AND AUTHORIZED SERVICE TECHNICIAN

Qualified and safety-trained specialist personnel of the manufacturer, or an outside company trained and authorized by the manufacturer for the installation and maintenance of KBL tanning devices.

1.5 Transport



1.5.1 TRANSPORT BY FORKLIFT TRUCK



During transport the tanning device may be damaged when using forklift forks that are too short.

• Use only sufficiently long forks.

The tanning device is mounted on a pallet.

- Insert the forks carefully into the openings of the pallet.
- Lift the load by a few centimeters.
- Transport the load carefully to the place of installation.

1.5.2 OTHER MODES OF TRANSPORT

If a forklift truck cannot be used for transport, the tanning device must be partially disassembled and the parts must be transported individually to the place of installation, e.g. using a dolly. Depending on the weight of the components, lifting them might require several people.

2. Safety notes

2.1 General safety notes

- Follow all instructions given in this manual and all other documents enclosed with the tanning device. In addition, observe all relevant statutory provisions and regulations, also those applicable in the country of operation.
- The tanning device must only be installed and assembled by qualified, trained and authorized service technicians.
- Arbitrary modifications or conversions of the tanning device are not permissible.
- Observe all danger signs and safety notices attached to the tanning device.
- Safety notices must not be removed, and safety equipment must not be disabled or removed.
- The tanning device must only be operated when in perfect working condition.
- Never operate the tanning device with the outer covers or acrylic panes removed.
- This tanning device must be operated with an external timer that is listed in compliance with UL 917.



- The bed must only be opened with bed pane folded down.
- The canopy is not designed to carry additional loads. In particular, during installation the canopy must not be charged with additional loads.

If, at any point, you determine that the ESSENTAIL PERFORMANCE of the tanning device has been impaired (due to electro-magnetic interference or other causes), then terminate installation / operation and consult the factory before continuing. Before carrying out any work, the tanning device must be disconnected from the mains voltage.



Hot device parts



Danger of burns from hot lamps and housing parts. If the tanning device was operated before being opened, lamps and housing parts may be hot.

• Wait until the tanning device has cooled down.

Danger of pinching

When assembling heavy components, you can pinch your fingers or hands.

- Wear assembly gloves.
- Be careful when handling heavy components.



3. Service mode

When the tanning device is in service mode, you can make the pre settings for operation in tanning mode, and you can have values concerning the operation of the tanning device displayed.

3.1 Call up service menu start window

3.2 Service menu - Start window

In standby mode, the service level is accessed by entering the factory CODE 1 "00000", the supplied CODE 2 or individually defined CODES.

There is one additional condition that must be fulfilled:

• No incoming signal from the coin-box system.





3.3 Service menu - Basics

The service menu is divided into the main menu and the function menu.

If you choose a menu item, e.g. "AUDIO", you will get access to all functions related to this item.

3.3.1 MAIN MENU

Quick navigation through the main group function bars using swipe gesture control.

Stepwise selection by touching the side arrow buttons.

3.3.2 FUNCTION MENU

Quick navigation through the subgroups using the quick selection bar.

Stepwise selection by touching the side arrow buttons or using swipe gesture control.







3.3.3 SERVICE MENU - BASIC OPERATION

Touch the desired main group function bar in the main menu. The current selected function bar is highlighted.



CHANGE SETTINGS (EXAMPLES)

Depending on the respective function, you can change values, select options and switch functions on or off.







Example: Switch functions on or off



STORE, BACK & EXIT

Save your settings by pressing the STORE button. If you fail to do so, the system will not take over the changes you made. See also chapter "Service Menu - Timeout".

- By pressing the STORE button, you save all changes you have made in all menu items!
- The STORE button is only visible when a change has occurred.



By pressing the BACK button you go back to the previous menu level.



By pressing the EXIT button you exit the service menu.

3.3.4 SERVICE MENU - TIMEOUT

After performing your last operating action, you have 2 minutes left to save the changes you have made. Then, a prompt appears and all changes are automatically discarded after an additional 20 seconds

3.3.5 SERVICE MENU - AUDIBLE SIGNALS

For user convenience the storage processes are acoustically acknowledged.

3.5 Service codes

3.5.1 SERVICE-CODE LEVEL 1

Access to the service menu start window is protected by CODE 1. When delivered, this CODE is **00000**. Optionally, the factory-set protection can be replaced by an individual CODE in the service menu, item

3.5.2 SERVICE-CODE LEVEL 2

Some menu items are protected by CODE 2. Each tanning device has its own CODE 2.

You will receive your CODE 2 (Service Code Level 2) with the tanning device documentation.



Optionally, the factory-set CODE 2 can be supplemented by an individual CODE 2 in the service menu, item

> <u>SERVICE/Service-Code Level 2</u> <

Access to the service menu start window can be done directly with the CODE 2. In this case all CODE 2 protected menu items are immediately activated.



- Individual CODES are not reset by loading the factory settings.
- The one-time input of CODE 2 immediately activates all protected menu items.



In the following chapter, you will recognize CODE 2 protected menu items by the CODE 2 logo.
